- Thrives in moist to wet soils perfect for pond edges or rain gardens

- Pinkish-Purple feathery plumes
- Compact tufted ornamental grass
- Season: Summer

Overdam

- Pinkish-Purple feathery plumes which mature to gray fumes
- Creamy-white leaves
- Compact tufted ornamental grass
- Season: Summer

Carex

brunnea Aureovariegata

 This small grass withshort rhizomes forms a fairly flexible, slightly hairy, dense, up- right tuft, measuring about 35 to 40cm (14 to 16in) in all directions.

Carex

Comans frosted curls

- Oblong, fleshy, shiny, evergreen leaves
- Leaves may acquire red tints when grown in direct sun

Evergold

 low clumping perennial sedge from Japan. Foliage is evergreen or semi-evergreen and arching

Gold band

- Handsome strap like leaves
- Banded at the edge with a rich golden

Carex

Ice Dance

- Narrow and shinny dark green leaves with bright white edges
- It bears inconspicuous brown flower spikes on long stems
- Season: Summer

Vanilla Ice

 An attractive evergreen sedge with arching variegated foliage that really catches the eye

Carex

Morrowi Irish Green

- Dense clumps of fine-textured, deep green arching foliage
- Provides a lush, grass-like appearance all year round
- Ideal for groundcover, borders, or container use









Carex Lax. Bunny Blue

- Low-growing clumps of broad, silvery-blue to blue-green foliage
- Soft, arching habit adds gentle texture and color contrast
- Ideal for shade gardens, woodland borders, or containers

- Brazen foliage

- Striking silver-blue foliage
- Produces wheat-colored plumes in summer


Ophiogon

Japonicus Minor

- compact low growing form
- short narrow evergreen leaves
- very occasional pale lilac flowers









Ophiogon Planiscapus Niger

 Looking much like a black Liriope, Black Mondo Grass is a compact, densely growing, clump forming, ever- green,grass-like plant.

Pennisetum

Hameln

- Showy silvery white foxtail flowers
- Bright green in summer, turn golden yellow in fall

Pennisetum

Little bunny

 warm season ornamental grass which typically grows in graceful, spreading clumps from 2-3' tall and as wide.
 Features narrow, medium to deep green leaves (to 1/2" wide) in summer, changing to golden yellow in fall and fading to beige in late fall. Foliage usually remains attractive throughout the winter

Pennisetum

Rubrum

- Has exceptionally long arching crimson plumes
- Topped with soft and fluffy red burgun- dy flowers

Most of our grasses are sold as unrooted cuttings as well as rooted plugs.
