Unrooted cuttings, rooted cuttings and boxes

Savanna Flowers produces rooted and unrooted cuttings and young plants. These are the basic requirements for our clients and we thus strive to remain simple but able to satisfy your basic needs.

UNROOTED SEDUM AND SUCCULENT CUTTINGS

The unrooted cuttings are harvested in units of 200-300 pieces/unit and depending on the variety packed 1200 -

1800 cuttings per box. The box size is 55 x 37 x 43 cm

Aeonium Arboreum Nigrum

- Dark purple, almost black rosettes
- Grow on the top of tall elegant stems



Crassula Minor

- Evergreen succulent with shiny leaves
- Blooms during winter



Crassula Ovata Gollum

- Interesting tubular leaves that have a reddish tint
- White star-like flowers, that often appear in late fall and early winter



Crassula Ovata Sunset

- glossy, rounded, fleshy green leaves adorned with golden yellow tips and red edges
- small starry white or pink flowers bloom in profusion from fall to spring



Crassula Schmidtii

- thick leaves are often covered with hair
- flowers are generally small and borne on terminal panicles



Crassula Sally sawtooth

- Extremely tightly packed, scale-like leaves
- Unbranched, upright stems if not pinched



Crassula Arboresens

• blue-grey foliage



Crassula Ovata

- Oblong, fleshy, shiny, evergreen leaves
- Leaves may acquire red tints when grown in direct sun



Crassula Ovata Horntree

- tube like leaves that look live horns
- Prefers bright light

Echeveria

Amoena

- yellow-orange flowers
- take on a red colouring in strong light



Echeveria Metallica

- spoon-shaped, wavyedged, metallic bronzegreen leaves with pink margins
- Racemes of bell-shaped reddish flowers are yellow inside



Echeveria Nodulosa

- deep-green leaves and burgundy through to pink markings
- blooms in the summer



Echeveria Peaccockii

- iridescent silver-blue leaves that can become tipped in red
- long-lasting flowers are pinkorange on slender stalks in early summer



Echeveria Pulvinata

- striking red, velvet coating
- These leaves are thick and spatulate



Echeveria Devotion

- warm burgundy color with green leaves feel velvety and super soft
- branched thin stems that are round and rod-shaped



Echeveria X set oliver

- base colour is a deep green
- entire rosette is covered in hairs that will show off a silver glow under strong light



Echeveria Hookeri

- silvery blue-green, pointed leaves
- leaf tips turn red with enough sun
- bell-shaped pink flowers atop stalks



Echeveria Lipstick

• green rosette with pointed leaves lined with crimson



Echeveria Elegans

- tight rosettes of pale greenblue fleshy leaves
- long slender pink stalks of pink flowers with yellow tips in winter and spring



Echeveria Rubra

- sharp-tipped leaves edged in red
- produces striking colours when subdued to long hours of sun



Echeveria Purpusorum

 Develops pointy leaves, and the whole plant grows into something resembling a fully bloomed rose flower pattern



Echeveria Agavoides

- forming rosettes of triangular, fleshy, evergreen leaves in pale green with red margins
- In spring and early summer, red, lantern-shaped flowers with yellow tips appear on tall stems



Echeveria Lilacina

- The leaves are silverygrey, spoon shaped, fleshy and arranged in a symmetrical rosette
- Flowers are pale pink or coral-colored



Kalanchoe Tomentosa

 Fleshy, oval-shaped leaves are densely covered in whitish hairs



Kalanchoe Thyrsiflora

 features a basal rosette of large, fleshy, wedge-shaped or paddle-shaped, stalkless, obovate, gray-green leaves
